The substantial contraction occurred as a result of the operations of the Foundation in a year when it did not receive any contributions.

There is no intent to liquidate, dissolve or terminate the Foundation at this time and there are no liquidation, dissolution or termination documents, plans or resolutions.

During the year ended November 30, 2004, the Foundation made and fully paid a grant of \$100,000 to The Open Society Institute, a private operating foundation, See Part XV of Form 990-PF and Statement 9 with respect to the grant.
